

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Asbestos Monitoring Waiver for

RANCH COUNTY WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT

Our water system has been granted a waiver for asbestos sampling. As our customers, you have the right to know why we are not sampling for asbestos.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator that the drinking water has or has not met health standards. We will not conduct monitoring for asbestos because we have been granted a waiver by DEQ. This waiver is based on our certification that there is no asbestos concrete pipe in the distribution system.
